In order to assist those who are struggling during COVID-19, some animal nonprofits have implemented free pet food programs. Currently, these nonprofits include:

- Free pet food available via Pet Food Pantry
 - Curbside pick-up Wednesdays and Fridays from 12:00 P.M. – 3:00 P.M.
 - Delivery available for homebound residents – call to request
 - Must live in Cleveland and be able to provide unemployment letter (electronic is fine)
- Other programs:
 - Low cost vaccines, free spay/neuter program, flea and parasite treatment and pet supplies
 - Must live in Cleveland and have total household income less than 150% of the federal poverty guidelines
