

## FROM FR. JOHN KIM

We all know the famous Psalm 23. This psalm, *The Lord is my Shepherd*, is attributed to King David who was a shepherd before being called to be King of Israel. I personally believe that it is one of the best-loved prayers in the Bible.

I would like to share with you this story related to Psalm 23. Two people were asked to recite it for a congregation. The first was a Shakespearean actor, a non-believer. He did a magnificent job. He used just the right tone of voice, the right inflection, the right emphasis, the right pace, and the right pauses. Every word was clearly and beautifully enunciated. All who heard him were deeply impressed.

Then the second man, a believer, stood up. His delivery was poor. So, too, was his diction. He used mostly the same tone throughout. He went too fast. Some of his emphasis was wrong. He paused in the wrong places. In short, he made just above every mistake an amateur reciter could make.

But he had one powerful thing going for him: he spoke from the heart. He meant every word he said. The result was that his listeners were deeply moved. Later, the actor came up to him and said, "Congratulations! You did a wonderful job."


"I think I did a terrible job. It's you who did a wonderful job," he replied.

"Believe me, you did a much better job than I. One thing came across very clearly: I know Psalm 23, but you know the Shepherd."

Notice that King David did not say, "The Lord is a shepherd," although that he is. Nor did he say, "The Lord is *the* shepherd," though that he is. What he said was, "The Lord is *my* shepherd." In other words, he was speaking from personal experience, out of a personal faith. That makes all the difference, doesn't it?

The true faith dwells in our heart, and when we hear the voice of a person who speaks from the heart, that voice carries a lot of meaning to our life. Who do you say that Jesus is? What is your answer? Does it come from your heart? Perhaps these could be good questions to reflect on during this week of *Good Shepherd*.


