


FROM FR. JOHN KIM

When the steward of Jesus' story was found out with his wrong doing, it must have been a very humbling and painful moment for him. But it could also have been a moment of salvation. Because it showed him the dishonesty reality in which he was living, it could have been a turning point in his life. But what happened? He continued on in his old dishonest ways. There was not the slightest change in his character.

We have witnessed the similar situation to our family, neighbor and even ourselves. Those who are accustomed to living in the light will return to the light. But those who are accustomed to living in the dark will, in all probability, return to the dark.

A firmly-rooted, straight tree returns to its old, upright self after the storm passes, whereas a firmly-rooted, crooked tree returns to its twisted self. When we compromise our integrity we do not lose our humanity, but we lose our sense of wholeness, our sense of being the same person all the time.

Jesus was not holding up the wicked servant as a model. He was saying that the children of light can learn something from the children of darkness. Then we should be able to figure out how to bring them back to the light. This process should be gentle, gradual and patient. If we suddenly bring them back to the light, they might not be accustomed to the light and end up with returning to the dark. The first step for everything is indeed prayer. That is where our firm foundation should be.
