For grades 3rd through 7th only:

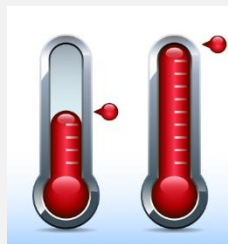

Dress Code Reminder:
