

Safety at Church

We are awaiting guidance from the diocese which should come at the beginning of next week, however, we would like to receive feedback from you on the following. Our thoughts are to relax practices where it does not compromise safety and to maintain practices that are not that big of a sacrifice.

Some examples/ideas include:

Continuing to maintain an "every other pew" configuration to keep people spread out

Continuing our practice of staying put in your pews with communion brought to you to avoid overcrowding

Continuing to use a separate pulpit for the

lector (most of our altar servers have not been vaccinated, so this gives them some extra protection)

Rely on the honor system for masks: *If you have* already been fully vaccinated (two weeks has passed since your final dose), masks are optional. Those not vaccinated should continue to wear a mask. This takes effect on June 2

Reopening the church during the day (with most sections roped off)

Once again, we need to wait for more directives from the diocese. These are only ideas at this point. We know many people come to our church because of its spaciousness and our commonsense protocols. We want everyone to continue to feel safe and comfortable at church.
