Saint John Lateran—The Pope’s Cathedral

You may think that St. Peter’s Basilica in Rome is the Pope’s Cathedral. Not so; it is the Basilica of St. John Lateran. and today we celebrate its consecration as the very first Christian church in the world. Back the early fourth century, when the Emperor Constantine became a Christian, he was given a palace that belonged to the Laterani and he in turn gave it to the bishop of Rome. It was then adapted to become a church and was dedicated on November 9th, in the year 324. Popes lived there for the next 1,000 years.

Over time, St. John Lateran suffered destruction either by invaders, fire, or earthquakes, and the popes moved out, ultimately relocating at St. Peter’s. But St. John Lateran remains to this day the cathedral of the Bishop of Rome, even though the popes have continued living at St. Peter’s.

Dedicación Basilica Letran

Mis queridos Hermanos: Hoy la Iglesia celebra una fiesta muy importante: la consagración de la Basilica de Letran. La Basilica de Letran es la catedral de la diócesis de Roma y, por tanto el papa, como obispo de Roma, tiene esta Basilica como su sede catedralicia. La celebración del aniversario de su dedicación expresa la comunión de cada Iglesia y comunidades locales con la Iglesia fundada por los apóstoles Pedro y Pablo, con el papa, cabeza del colegio episcopal, el Papa preside en la caridad todas las Iglesia del mundo. Las lecturas ponen el acento en el significado del templo. Cristo es el verdadero templo. Del templo mana la fuente de agua viva (primera lectura). Este templo que es Jesus mismo, es el "lugar" privilegiado para expresar y vivir, en la plegaria, la comunión profunda que los hombres podemos tener con Dios. El cristiano, por la presencia del Espíritu, es edificio de Dios (segunda lectura).

EL TEMPLO, LUGAR DE ENCUENTRO CON DIOS.

Uno de los aspectos mas importantes del cristiano es que la vivencia de su fe no es solo una cuestión estrictamente personal, privada, sino que la fe en Cristo resucitado ha de ser celebrada con los que tenemos una misma fe. Durante los tres primeros siglos del cristianismo, los cristianos no tenían ni templo ni iglesia donde reunirse. Cuando Pablo habla de la Iglesia que esta en Roma o Corinto se refiere a la comunidad cristiana que vivía en aquellas ciudades. Para el cristiano el templo no es tanto la casa de Dios como la casa donde se encuentra el pueblo de Dios, donde la familia y la comunidad cristiana se reúnen en nombre de Dios. Una comunidad en la que cada uno se ha de sentir llamado, salvado por Cristo, sentirse salvado significa que cada miembro es consciente de sus limitaciones, de su debilidad y también de sus cualidades, de su fuerza. Hoy, como ayer, formamos parte de ella unas personas que a pesar de nuestra pobreza podemos participar, todos, en el 'agape sagrado' (la eucaristía) al que Cristo nos ha convocado. Con la fuente de agua viva somos purificados, santificados.

Hoy tenemos la oportunidad de reflexionar sobre nuestra consagración bautismal porque ella nos hizo templo de Dios. Mis hermanos, esforcemonos en vivir esta realidad en la que esta 'nuestra dignidad de Hijos de Dios'. Vivamos nuestro bautismo!
