Counting The Cost Of Discipleship

Based upon the readings for
13th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In Luke, chapter 14 verse 28-30, it says ⁸“Suppose one of you wants to build a tower. Won’t you first sit down and estimate the cost to see if you have enough money to complete it? ²⁹For if you lay the foundation and are not able to finish it, everyone who sees it will ridicule you,³⁰ saying, ‘This person began to build and wasn’t able to finish.’”

This is the way for many of us Christians. Often, we begin in the Spirit and finish in the flesh. One may have begun by confessing Christ and rejoicing in church, but as soon as it comes to one’s daily life, colleagues notice that the alleged “Christian” still lies, backbites, pilfers, etc. Then colleagues say to each other, “He is supposed to be a Christian.” Then they mock us.

We must remember that Christianity is warfare. We must sit down and calculate whether we are able to overcome the king (Satan) who is coming against you. If we find from our calculations that we are not able to have victory, then it is not uncommon for some “Christians” to seek compromise with the devil.

Jesus did not come for His disciples to seek compromise with sin. He conquered sin. He conquered Satan, and all the spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heaven alone.

While it is possible to come to Jesus to get rid of the burden of sin; considerably more is required of disciples. We must forsake all that we have. This does not mean that we are to give away everything we own, but rather that all we own should be at the disposal of the Spirit’s prompting and leading, so that nothing comes upon us unexpectedly. And, it is only when we have made those kinds of calculations and concluded that it is possible to stand the test, that we are truly disciples of Jesus Christ.

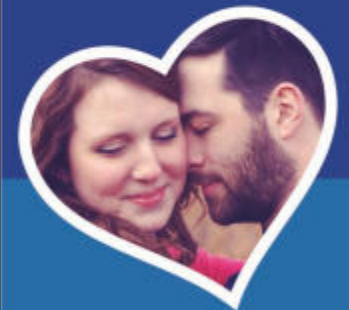
