Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,
How do I pray? I've been preaching and writing about this the last couple weeks. This last weekend I preached about the importance of meditation, of taking time to *listen* to the Word of God by pondering over it on our heart, using this wonder to lead us into a more intimate conversation with him, even to the point of simply resting in God's presence, knowing it is good to be with him, to receive his embrace.

Taking some time to stop and step away and pray is fundamental: but it is just important to keep up the ancient practice of *praying always*, as St. Paul teaches (1 Thes 5:16). We can't spend all day meditating, though we should always spend at least a little time each doing that. But we can always habitually *keep God in mind*. This can be as simple as praising and thanking him in those little moments throughout the day, or offering a pray of intercession for someone in need. Really, it's not much more than keeping the habit of frequently *remembering* him: remembering that we are always in his presence; remembering that we only ever live and move and have our being from and through his power; and remembering that he is always calling us, drawing us closer to his heavenly life.

There are four great prayers we can use to keep up this habit of praying always.

When we rise in the morning we should say: *I offer this day to you Lord, all my thoughts, intentions, and actions, for you glory, for the Church, and for all the world.* We call this the Morning Offering.

At noon, a traditional prayer to make is the Angelus:

The Angel of the Lord declared to Mary: and she conceived of the Holy Spirit. Hail Mary.... Behold the handmaid of the Lord: Be it done unto me according to Thy word. Hail Mary.... And the Word was made Flesh: And dwelt among us. Hail Mary... Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God, that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

At 3:00pm, the hour of mercy, when our Savior died for us, a great prayer to say is:

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole

world. For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

And before we go to bed, it is good to make an examination of our day, confessing to God our sins, and then praying like this:

O my God, I am sorry for all my sins because I have offended you. I want to love you above all things. Help me to do better tomorrow, and to avoid anything that might lead me to sin. Into your hands, Lord, I commend my spirit. Protect me, Lord, as I stay awake; watch over me as I sleep, that awake, I may keep watch with Christ, and asleep, rest in his peace.

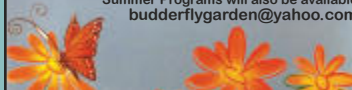
