Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,  
I hope you've been enjoying these few weeks we've spent reflecting on the importance of prayer.

It really can't be emphasized enough: prayer is the lifeblood of our parish. We can conceive and implement however many plans and programs we want, we can fundraise and organize and bring in more volunteers and hire more employees, we can build and renovate and landscape: none of these parish activities will matter at all if we do not pray. Because this work we are doing together—building the Body of Christ, proclaiming the Good News, making disciples and growing in holiness and fellowship in the Spirit—these are gifts of almighty God, graces that only he can provide. And God can give any of these gifts easily, in no time; but what he wants is our worship, our obedience, our holiness, our growth in charity. The instrument of all these gifts has always been, and will only ever be, prayer.

With prayer, so many amazing possibilities will come to this parish; without prayer, nothing we try will succeed. There are so many reasons to pray, not least of all because it is the way to bring ourselves closer to our one, true happiness. But another very important reason is that prayer is the most important means we have to build up our parish. So let us commit together to pray more deeply, more earnestly, more desperately: asking, pleading with our Lord, that he build up this parish as he wills, that he dispose us to be his instruments, to do the great things he has in store for this church.

Which brings me to my next point: as you may have heard, this Saturday, September 28<sup>th</sup>, we are having a half-day parish workshop, in order to prepare to reinstitute a parish advisory council. I invited a representative section of parishioners to share and reflect on the history of the parish, to discuss the current realities and challenges our parish faces, and to discern how we can face these with hope and resolve, confident that God has a plan for us, believing that we can achieve it together by his grace. I hope this workshop will begin

some important conversations, as well as provide me, your administrator, with important feedback, as we continue to work at building up this parish and looking to its future growth.

It's one of my goals to listen to this parish and hear where we are, so we can discern together what God is asking of us. Please know I always welcome your feedback, and I will keep you posted as we get closer to getting our parish council going again.

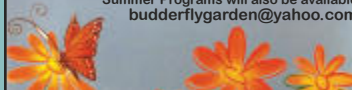
