On August 14th, a strong earthquake hit Haiti, killing many Haitians, wounding others, and causing catastrophic damage. This terrible event comes on the heels of the widespread economic and health crisis caused by COVID-19, further complicating rescue efforts. Local priests, religious Sisters and Brothers, and lay pastoral workers are already on the ground trying to bring relief to those affected by the earthquake. They are in need of food, water and medicine to administer to the needy. Please give generously next week, Sunday, August 29th, to help those suffering in Haiti.
