Through the work of these churches, and their witness to Christ, the poor receive practical help and experience God's love, mercy, hope, and peace. Please be generous with you gifts.

**Synod opening Mass invokes the guidance of the Holy Spirit for a period of listening to one another.** Local participation in the 2023 Synod of Bishops launched on Oct. 17<sup>th</sup>, 2021 with a Mass at which Washington Cardinal Wilton Gregory said the great challenge of the two-year synodal process is for all parts of the Catholic Church to participate... Every member of the Church must feel the sincere invitation to participate in the synodal process," Cardinal Gregory said in his homily. "We should be inspired to speak honestly with one another and to listen sincerely. We must not be afraid to hear the voices of those who may feel distant from the Church, or who have grown frustrated or scandalized by our past."
