If you are unable to join us on Saturday, there will be an additional opportunity to receive the Eucharist on Sunday. Mass will be live streamed at 10:00 a.m. Then, from 11:00 – 11:45 a.m., parishioners are welcome to drive to Saint Alexis to receive the Eucharist. We ask that you park and exit your car. **MASKS ARE REQUIRED!** Those wishing to receive the Eucharist should line up (6 feet apart per family) to enter the church through the side entrance adjacent to the bell tower. You are requested to use hand sanitizer provided, proceed forward into the Narthex, remove your mask immediately before receiving, receive the Eucharist, replace your mask, and exit the opposite side of the church into the parking lot facing the old church, opposite of where you entered. Please hand sanitize again when exiting. **NO ENTRY INTO THE BODY OF THE CHURCH WILL BE PERMITTED AT THIS TIME.**

PLEASE NOTE:

- Per the directives received from the Diocese of Pittsburgh, the Holy Eucharist will be distributed at the end of all Masses. Following live stream Masses, parishioners can remain in their vehicles until ushers indicate that distribution of the Eucharist is beginning.
- Except for weekday Mass on Tuesday and Thursday, Saint Alexis Church will remain closed to the public for cleaning and sanitizing. Only the Narthex is open on Sunday morning for the distribution of the Eucharist. Saint Alphonsus Church remains closed to the public except for the Saturday distribution of the Eucharist in the Narthex.
- We continue to encourage everyone if able to receive the Eucharist by hand. If unable or unwilling to receive by hand, please wait until the end of the distribution to receive, as the clergy will need to clean their hands and sanitize after each of those distributions, whether or not they suspect the tongue was touched.
- Access to the Tabernacle shrine for private prayer continues 24 hours per day, with Adoration on Tuesday evenings from 7:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.
- Confession times continue every Saturday from 11:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. in Father Rodgers Hall (the former Saint Alexis Church building). Face masks are required.
- The Parish Center remains closed to the public until further notice.
- Please understand that all of the “rules and regulations” outlined here have been recommended and directed by the Diocese of Pittsburgh.
