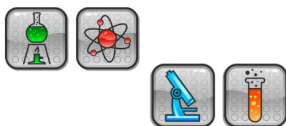

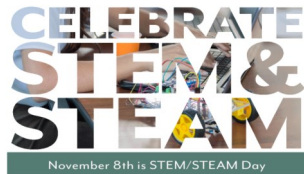
## National Youth Leadership Forum, STEM...

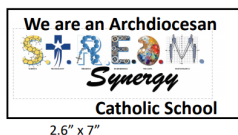
