

Family Formation Pricing Scenarios for Annunciation Parishioners

- **Family 1** has two parents and 4 children (one toddler, one in 2nd-grade, one in 4th-grade, and one in 5th-grade). The cost for faith formation is \$125 for the year for the family program and \$0 for 1st Reconciliation Prep.
- **Family 2** has one parent and 2 children (one is in 8th-grade and one is in 9th-grade). The 9th-grade student would like to be Confirmed in high school. The cost for faith formation is \$150 for this family (\$125 for the family program and \$25 for the Confirmation Year A program).
- **Family 3** has two parents and 2 children (one in 9th-grade and one in 10th-grade). The cost for formation is \$150 (\$75 for each high school student AND the family is welcome to attend Week 1 Family Formation for FREE if they would like to).
- **Family 4** has two parents and 2 children (one in 12th-grade - already Confirmed, and one in college). The cost is FREE for family formation, once a month.

Family Formation Pricing Scenarios for Non-Parishioners*

- **Family 1** has two parents and 4 children (one toddler, one in 2nd-grade, one in 4th-grade, and one in 5th-grade). The cost for faith formation is \$175 for the year for the family program and \$25 for the 1st Reconciliation Prep. Total of \$200.
- **Family 2** has one parent and 2 children (one is in 8th-grade and one is in 9th-grade). The 9th-grade student would like to be Confirmed in high school. The cost for faith formation is \$275 for this family (\$175 for the family program and \$100 for the Confirmation Year A program).
- **Family 3** has two parents and 2 children (one in 9th-grade and one in 10th-grade). The cost for formation is \$200 (\$100 for each high school student AND the family is welcome to attend Week 1 Family Formation for FREE if they would like to).
- **Family 4** has two parents and 2 children (one in 12th-grade - already Confirmed, and one in college). The cost is FREE for family formation, once a month.

*Annunciation heavily subsidizes its faith formation program thanks to the generosity of its parishioners through weekly collections. Non-parishioners are asked to pay a little more to help defer some of the additional costs not covered by tuition.
