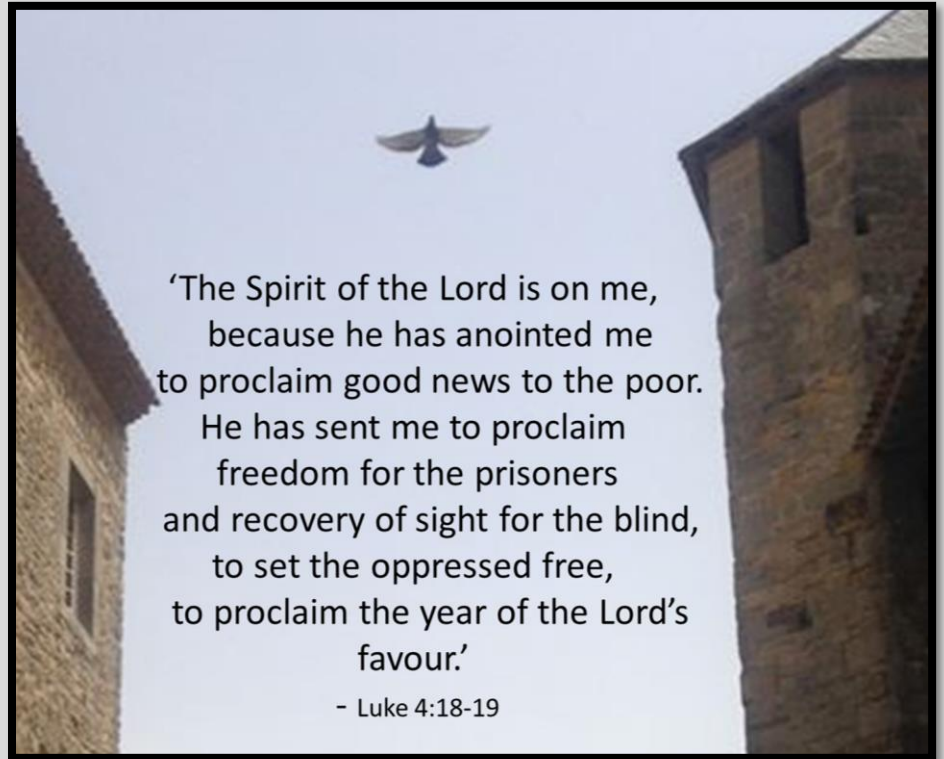

The Pastor's Corner:

Today's Gospel, presenting Jesus' "inaugural address" in the synagogue of Nazareth, marks a great moment in Jewish history. The Scripture readings for today focus our attention on the importance and liberating power of the Word of God as "sacramental," making God present in our midst. The readings challenge us to listen to the Word, accept it into our hearts, then put it into practice as we live out our lives, thus liberating ourselves and others from all types of bondage.

Jesus claims that He is the One sent "to bring glad tidings to the poor, liberation to captives, recovery of sight to the blind and freedom for the oppressed"—language that reflects the Biblical year of Jubilee. To the great amazement and disbelief of His own townsmen, Jesus declares that Isaiah's prophecy is being fulfilled at that very moment "in their hearing," because the prophecy foretells and describes Jesus' own mission and ministry. Jesus' mission is still to give liberation to everyone who will listen to His "Good News," accept it and put it into practice.
