The Pastor's Corner:

The call of Jeremiah, prophet of the late seventh and early sixth centuries B.C., is featured in today's first reading. Jeremiah had a special relationship with God ("Before you were born, I consecrated you"). His mission was enormously challenging ("stand up and tell them everything that I command you") and the Lord would protect him. Jeremiah is a courageous spokesperson! In our gospel, Luke presents Jesus today as a prophet heralding the dawning of a new age. The people's reaction is disconcerting. First there is amazement, how could this local citizen claim such power? Then there is indignation -- a plot to slay the prophet by hurling him over the edge of the hill! Obviously, pain and hostility must be endured before Jesus' new age comes to glory.

The Feast of St. Blaise is February 3. Saint Blaise was the bishop of Sebastea and a doctor. The first known record of the saint's life comes from the medical writings of Aëtius Amidenus, where he is recorded as helping with patients suffering from objects stuck in their throat. Many of the miraculous aspects of St. Blaise's life are written of 400 years after his martyrdom in the "Acts of St. Blaise." Saint Blaise is believed to begin as a healer then, eventually, became a "physician of souls." He then retired to a cave, where he remained in

prayer. People often turned to Saint Blaise for healing miracles. Blessing of Throats will take place after all Masses this weekend 2nd & 3rd February.

Presentation Of Jesus In The Temple... Another Lesson In Obedience

*"The sons of wisdom are the church of the just:
and their generation, obedience and love."*

-Ecclesiastes 3:1

This scene sets the stage for the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple. Keep these events in mind as well as the fruit of the mystery which is the virtue of obedience. You will find it helpful to look at a picture of the Presentation of Jesus or even listen to some music that will uplift your soul...

Mary and Joseph take the baby Jesus to Jerusalem "to present him to the Lord" -Luke 2:22

The presentation of Jesus in the temple is in fulfillment with the Jewish law. Every male child must be taken to the temple and an animal must be offered as a sacrifice. That is why Joseph is usually artistically depicted in this scene holding a cage with two doves in it. The prophet Simeon and the prophetess Anna meet the Holy Family while at the temple in Jerusalem. Simeon was told by God that he would see the Savior before he died. When Simeon sees baby Jesus, he takes Him from Mary and holds Him in his arms and praises God proclaiming, "Now thou dost dismiss thy servant, O Lord, according to thy word in peace; Because my eyes have seen thy salvation" -Luke 2:29 Simeon then blesses Mary and Joseph and prophesies to Mary: "Behold this child is set for the fall, and for the resurrection of many in Israel, and for a sign which shall be contradicted; And thy own soul a sword shall pierce, that, out of many hearts, thoughts may be revealed." -Luke 34-35

Even though this is a joyful occasion you can see in the words of Simeon a foreshadow of the sorrows that will be shared between Jesus and his Mother Mary.

Mary suffered with Jesus from the beginning to the end. Anna also proclaims that this child, the baby Jesus, is the long-awaited Messiah. After all this the Holy Family leaves Jerusalem and returns to Nazareth. There they live in peace and joy for many years before Jesus begins His public life.

For the Bible says...
