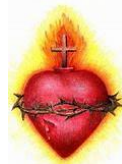

The Pastor's Corner:

As we begin this season of Lent, we are called to meditate upon the mystery of Jesus' time in the desert shortly before he began His public ministry. The Holy Scriptures teach us that Jesus experienced intense temptations during those forty days of prayer and fasting, but He also experienced profound refreshment from God the Father. My prayer for all of us is that this Lenten season be a time of growing ever closer to Jesus and being willing to enter into his sufferings. But, may it also be a season of profound joy in experiencing his beauty in all of creation.

Safe Haven Sunday: *Equipping the Family, Safeguarding Children* The family home is to be a safe haven. But the inappropriate use of technology in the home deprives it of this role and is the greatest threat to the sanctity of marriages and families today. Pornography and other online threats are often one click away, and parents can feel overwhelmed with not knowing how to best protect their children in our fast-paced digital world.
