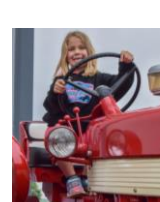
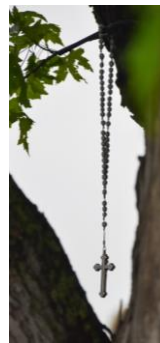
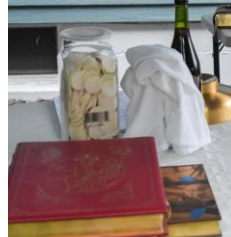
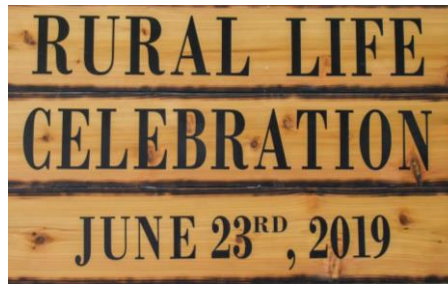


The Pastor's Corner:

The first reading today dramatizes a transition that is not fearful, but even gracious. With complete trust, Elijah anoints Elisha as his successor, just as the Lord had asked. Elisha does not push aside the older prophet, but shows him reverence, "Then he set out and followed Elijah, and became his servant". The prophets' mutual respect is echoed in Galatians: "Through love become slaves to one another". Paul teaches today that the Christian's ability to serve is based on freedom. The fundamental freedom won by Christ is found not around us, but within us. This gift is chosen when we free ourselves from selfishness by taking responsibility for our decisions, by reaching beyond ourselves to others in love. "The whole law is summed up in a single commandment: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself'".

Discipleship requires a wholehearted commitment to the Lord and a generous spirit of service toward his people. The demands are severe. Jesus, in today's gospel, says, "No one who puts a hand to the plow and looks back is fit for the kingdom of God" (*Luke 9:62*). The people of Jesus' time understood this agrarian imagery. The farmer has to keep his eyes fixed straight ahead, otherwise the neatly organized field required for planting, would be turned into a chaotic nightmare at harvesting time.
