**Today's Gospel** begins immediately after the final verse in last Sunday's Gospel. After strong language about the difficulties of discipleship, Jesus immediately appoints 72 people to go ahead of Him to every town and place He plans to visit, proclaiming that the Kingdom of God is at hand. He sends them in pairs.

Jesus admits it will be difficult, that he is sending them out like lambs among wolves. Yet, they are to bring nothing with them, not even a money bag or sandals. They are to greet no one on the way so as not to be distracted from their mission. When they enter a house, their message is simply "peace." The response they will receive may be positive or negative. Either way, they are to know that the Kingdom of God is at hand.

**A key theme of today's Gospel and last Sunday's Gospel is discipleship**—its challenges, its difficulties, and its rewards. Sharing in the mission of Jesus is difficult, but everyone is called to do it, not just some professionals trained for ministry. Even for us today, the harvest is plentiful. We should pray to the Master of the harvest to send out workers for His harvest. This gospel is so fitting as we hear from Fr. Les of Glenmary Missionaries for our annual Missionary Appeal to support the work of spreading the gospel. As is our practice in our parishes, please be generous to the annual mission appeal.
