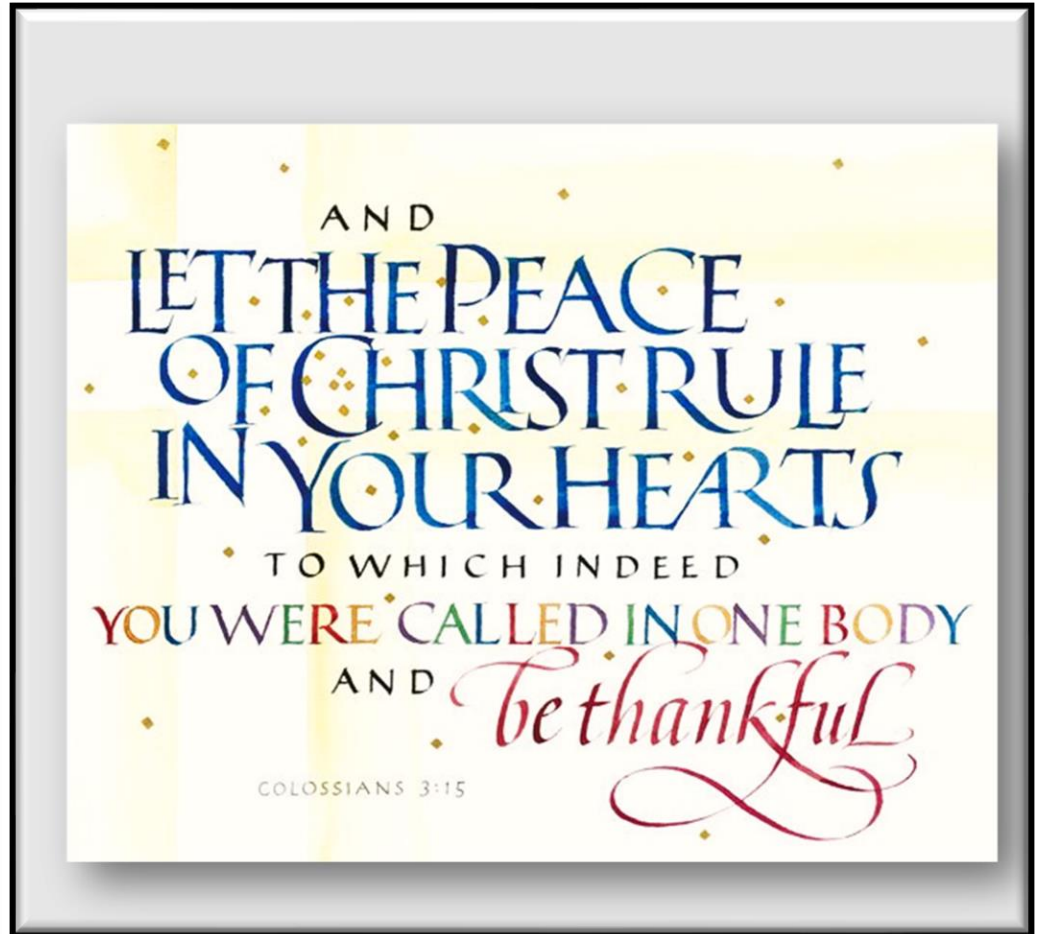

so that nothing may frighten or worry us, for, living close to You, we shall see Your hand, Your purpose, Your will through all things.

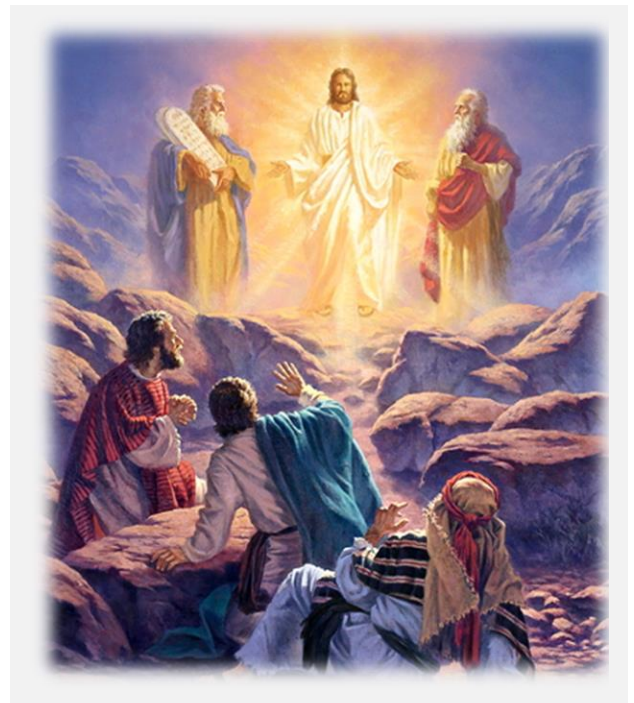

The Pastor's Corner:

"Vanity of vanities," says today's first reading, "All is vanity!" If we think that material possessions will make us happy, we will spend half our time trying to acquire them and the other half trying to protect them. And in the end, they must all be left behind!

In today's Gospel, Jesus, telling the parable of the foolish rich man, warns the disputing brothers, and us, against all types of greed, because greed takes our life's focus away from God and away from serving and loving Him in other people. Jesus says God called the greedy rich man a fool because the man thought he would not die soon and that he was not accountable for his riches. He forgot that his wealth had been lent to him by God for sharing with the needy. Jesus also warns us that "our eternal life does not consist of earthly possessions" (Luke 12:15), so we should share our possessions to gain eternal life. "Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth," admonishes Paul (Colossians 3:2). Material things are good, but they are not God!
