**COMFORTING THOSE WHO MOURN:** Often times, we struggle to know how to help someone who is grieving. This can keep us from reaching out at a time when a grieving family member or friend may need it most. For the next several weeks, I will share some helpful tips on how to comfort those who mourn. The most important tip of all is to remember that mourning is a natural and normal response to the loss of a loved one. The process of grief requires time and patience as the griever moves through the process of shock, suffering, and eventually finding a new normal (recovery). The shock period can last minutes, hours, or even days. The suffering period can include many emotions: sadness, anger, guilt, anxiety, and may show in physical ways, through behavior, and can affect how a person thinks and processes things. This period can last weeks or even months for some. Recovery is the goal of grieving, however it is not the elimination of the pain and memories, instead the goal is to reorganize one's life so that the loss is one important part of life, rather than the center of one's life. ## The Pastor's Corner:

**In our scriptures this Feast of Christ the King**, we see that royalty has its privileges. Kings and queens, princes and princesses, are expected to live in castles where their wishes are the will of the court. But what about the court? Heads of state are subject, like anyone else, to the gospel mandate of justice and charity. All are called to serve! David, king of the southern realm of Judah for over seven years, wished to reign over the northern kingdom of Israel as well. In today's account, the tribes gather in the south to affirm David as Yahweh's choice and to anoint him as king of all the Chosen People. The partners will be loyal to one another through thick and thin. The royal David pledges care for the needs of all. The passage from Colossians describes a dispute raging in the community. Some held that angelic intermediaries were the agents of creation and had control over human destiny. The author of this letter says that creation is ruled by God's power, a power now manifested.

**Happy Thanksgiving:** We have the opportunity to give thanks at our Thanksgiving Masses and our ecumenical services in our cluster. St. Adrian will have the eve Mass and OLG will have the morning Mass this year.
