COMFORTING THOSE WHO MOURN: Grieving is a natural part of any type of loss. Whether we lose a job, a loved one, or a friendship, we go through a time of mourning the loss of what once was. When losing a loved one our grief and mourning will be determined by our unique abilities to deal with uncomfortable or traumatic experiences. We all deal with grief in ways that works for us, and the time it takes to work through the varying emotions and feelings will be unique to each person experiencing it. But sometimes grief can become complicated which makes it harder to work through. Some things that may complicate grief are: the status of our relationship to the deceased, our attitudes and views toward death, our ability to handle trauma, or the circumstances of the death. At our parish cluster, we have a wonderful grief workshop that has helped many people move through their grief journey in a healthy way. **The workshop is called “Grieving with Great Hope” and it consists of 5 sessions (once a week) which last about an hour and a half each.** Part of the session includes watching a DVD in which we hear stories from others who have lost loved ones as well as helpful information on grieving and what to expect and how to do it well. There is an opportunity for participants to share their feelings, however it is never forced. Physician Assisted Suicide Myth: Look, I'm dying anyway. Why not end the process before it gets even harder? **Truth:** God has a purpose for your life. His son Jesus Christ died for you, to open to you a path to the Father. But you have been given a mission. God has rich possibilities for your life, even on your deathbed, that you do not know—but He does. Do not shut out the Lord's possibilities for your life. He will grace you in the difficulties and we will not abandon you. Dying is difficult, but it is also sacred ground. If you intentionally and with full knowledge end your life, you shut God out. **Catholic compassion:** Dying can be hard, but we can help. For centuries, the Christian faith has helped people die well. Request the sacrament of anointing of the sick early in the process for the grace of peace. Pray and request prayer. Forgive friends and family. Ask for help. We have millions of witnesses of people who have died well and with peace. We can't promise it won't be hard, but we can promise you will not be alone and God is with you.

The Pastor's Corner:

Light eliminates our darkness and eases our tension. The metaphor of light goes all the way back to the first chapter of Genesis when the creation of light means the end of chaos. This same imagery is found in today's Scriptures. The author of the prophet Isaiah points out that a genuine fast means that if bread is shared with the hungry "then your light shall break forth like the dawn" (Isaiah 58:8). The image of light clarifies the thrust of graciousness, mercy, and justice. Matthew reminds Christians that they are commissioned to enlighten humanity, "You are the light of the world" (*Matthew 5:14*). Matthew develops this dimension of Christian discipleship by comparing Christ's followers to a city perched on a hill, clear and visible. Disciples shed light on darkness; to renege on this task would be to hide a lamp under a bushel basket.

Once again, we are making a *Covenant Eyes* booklet available for families to help parents navigate Online Exposure to pornography on the web and keep your children safe from pornography. This year's booklet is called ***Confident***. Know how to talk to your children about chastity and what is appropriate in our highly sexualized culture.
