
FIFTH SUNDAY IN LENT MARCH 29, 2020





The Pastor's Corner:

In today's Word of God, we deal with the very real problems of anxiety and hopelessness. How fitting during this time of the covid19 pandemic. When life's shocks paralyze us, when self-pity becomes the expression of our misery, then we must call upon the God who becomes involved in human tragedy. This is the God whose concern for the living is a manifestation of life itself. Preaching in the aftermath of the destruction of Jerusalem, Ezekiel personally experienced the frustration of that of an exile. He even guotes their expression of despair: "Our bones are dried up, and our hope is lost" (Ezekiel 37:11). His response is a vision in which he is transported to a valley littered with dry human bones. At the prophet's word, the breath/spirit/wind brings the bodies to life. For God's despondent people this means that Yahweh will call them back to new life in their own land of Israel. John recounts the raising of Lazarus as a sign that transforms the tragedy into hope. Lazarus' illness and death are the occasion for the manifestation of God's glory. Faith goes hand in hand with glory. To accept Jesus is to make oneself open to that whole process of transformation. The disciple glorifies God just as the Son did by his death and resurrection.

To experience the presence of God makes hope possible and life livable. Breathing life into the weary downtrodden is in the tradition of Ezekiel; caring for the elderly and the shut-ins is in the spirit of Paul; alleviating hunger for the world's starving poor follows the Gospel of John. All these deeds manifest the glory of God.
