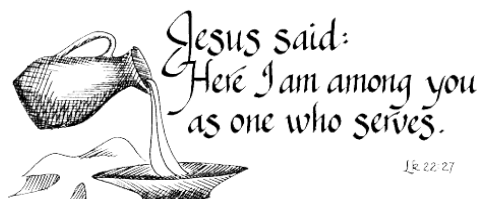

## The Pastor's Corner:

The covid-19 virus pandemic has certainly reminded us of our human condition. Suffering is part of our lives. One of the great beauties of our faith is that there is value in every aspect of the Christian's life, even those aspects of life that are full of pain. Therefore, we give it all to the Lord. We read the Passion account again this Palm Sunday, reminding us how Jesus embraced the cross. If our health is poor or failing, if our lives are not going as we hoped, whatever pain we have, we give it to Him. We unite everything to the cross so others can experience the Sacrificial Love of Jesus in our lives. We focus on the cross today, and throughout this Holy Week. We unite our pains to Jesus' pains. We receive His healing through His Cross. We bring His healing to others by allowing them to experience the Power of the Cross at work in our lives. We are called to participate in Redemptive Suffering. Besides our parish live streaming of Holy Week Services, there are the Diocese of Winona-Rochester Holy Week Liturgies that will also be live-streamed from the Cathedral in Winona.
