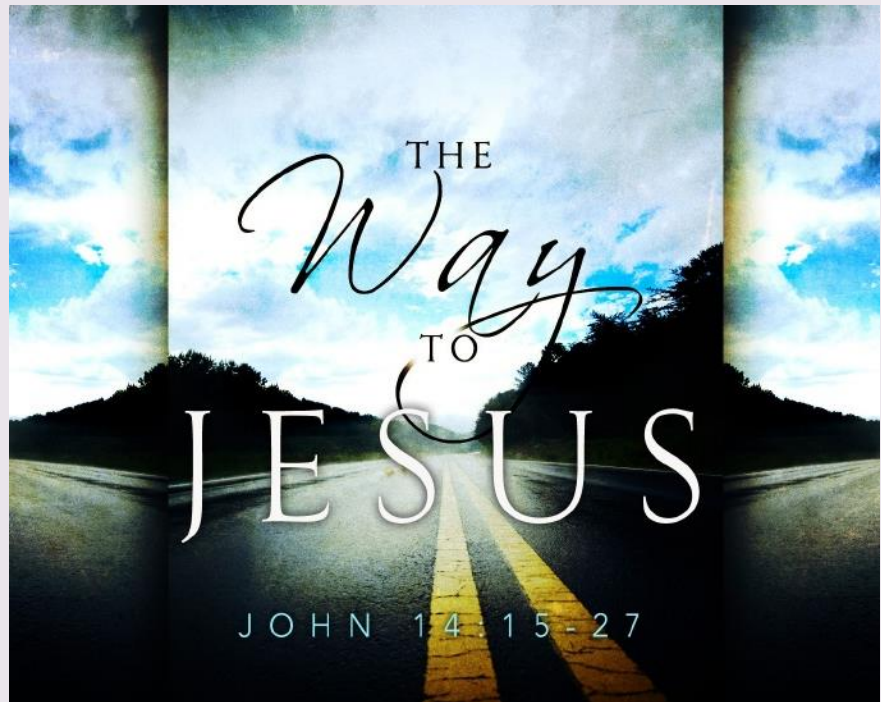

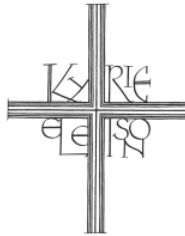

The Pastor's Corner:

In today's gospel Jesus promises the Holy Spirit, the assurer of the peace, the fount of all spiritual activity in the church. The Holy Spirit would come down upon the apostles on Pentecost. The church would need that Spirit of peace, and love and strength, to allow it to survive without the physical presence of Jesus. Jesus promises this Spirit in the gospel where He says: "If you obey the commands I give you, I will ask the Father and he will give you another Paraclete – to be with you always: the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot accept, since it neither sees him nor recognizes him; but you can recognize him because he remains with you and will be within you" (*John 14:15-16*).

Today we rejoice that Jesus promises to send us a helper, a Paraclete, who will be with us now that Jesus is no longer physically with us; a Paraclete who will lead us to that final reunion where we will be with Jesus in heaven and all our loved ones.
