## The Pastor's Corner:

In today's gospel passage, our Lord instructs his new disciples to have no fear and does so three times in this short passage. He tells the disciples that they should not be afraid of what others can do to them. He explains this by saying that "Nothing is concealed that will not be revealed, and nothing hidden that will not become known." His meaning here is that the truth will eventually win out in any situation. For example, consider St. Joan of Arc. Although she was put to death for what she did, she was exonerated after her death when her true intentions became known and her prophecies came true. She went from being castigated, and burned as a witch and a heretic, to sainthood. Then our Lord tells the disciples "What I tell you in darkness, speak in the light. What you hear in private, proclaim from the housetops." What I believe our Lord is stressing in the first part of each of these sentences is that his disciples set aside time for prayer and to reflect on what is happening in our lives and discern what the Spirit is telling us. Today's gospel reminds us that God cares deeply for each one of us. Enough to send his only Son to suffer and die for us so that we may attain eternal life with Him.

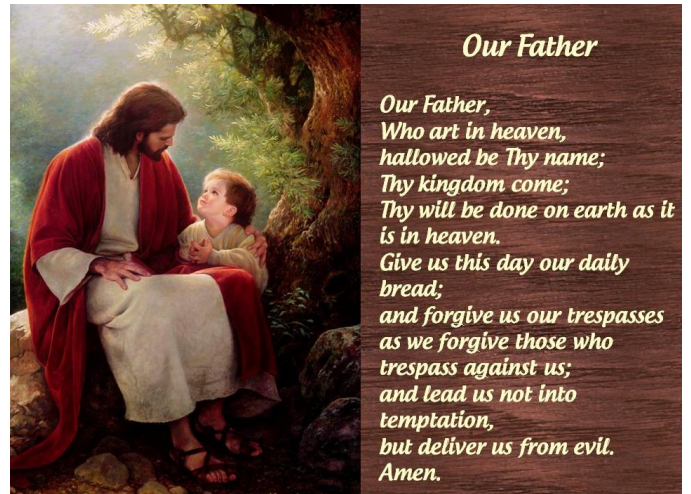
