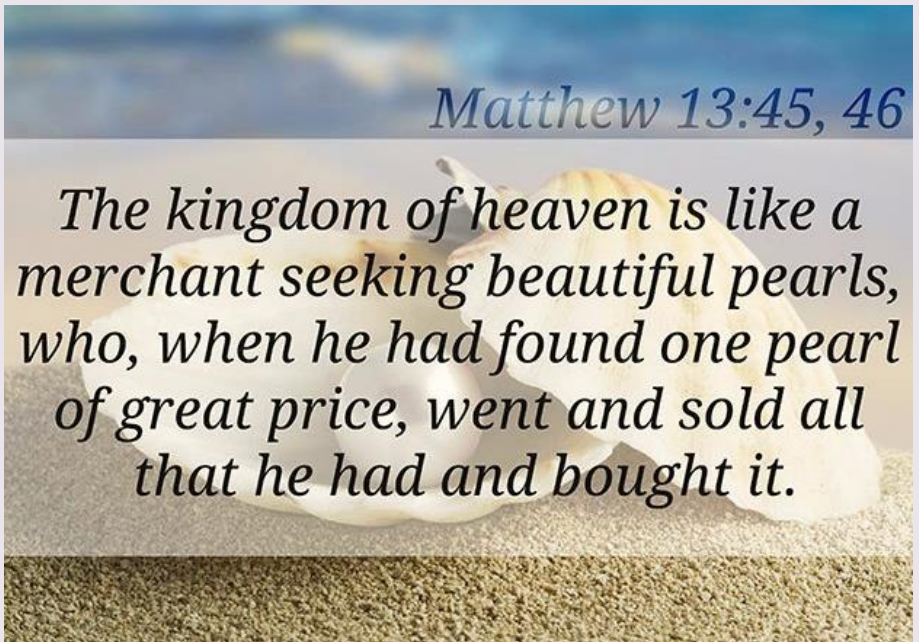

Our small community is reeling after the deaths of four young men in three months. All are graduates of Adrian. We weep alongside the parents who had the unthinkable task of burying their children. We weep with classmates and friends. We mourn the loss of relationships ended too soon.

We pray for healing for Mitchell Wagner who was injured in the same boating accident June 13 that took the life of Logan Nelson. We lift in prayer the families of: Landon Rogers, 20 Josh Winselman, 34 Logan Nelson, 22 Ryan Klenken, 37 We pray for all whose lives have been touched by tragedy.

For those who mourn Lord, immerse them in your love and lead them through this darkness into your arms, and light. For those who comfort, be in both the words they use and all that is left unspoken; fill each heart with love. We ask this through Jesus Christ, whose own suffering brought us life, here and for eternity. Amen

From the Pastor:

"The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure buried in a field, which a person finds and hides again, and out of joy goes and sells all that he has and buys that field. Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant searching for fine pearls. When he finds a pearl of great price, he goes and sells all that he has and buys it" (Matt 13:44-46).

The Gospel of Matthew this weekend gives us two parables that are as true for us today, as it was for those Palestinians to whom Christ spoke. All Christians are called on to imitate the two wise men, and surrender all their earthly possessions if necessary in order to gain eternal life. Does this "giving all" mean that we are all expected to abandon the world and take on the religious vows of poverty, chastity and obedience? There are many who do just this. But it is not the only way, nor the normal way, to purchase the eternal treasure. Heaven is within the reach of all, who follow the ordinary vocations of life and partake of this world's joys *within the framework of God's commandments*, but never lose sight of the goal toward the heavenly life to which they are moving.
