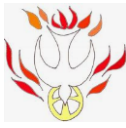
Pastoral Council Meeting: The next Pastoral Council Meeting will be on **Monday, September 14th at 7:00 PM** at OLGC, Wilmont.

Pastor's Corner:

In this Sunday's scriptures, we see Ezekiel enter upon a new phase in his prophetic career around the year 585 B.C. Earlier he was the scolder; now he is sentry for God's people in exile. In this passage, he dramatizes the tension between individual and community. Chapter 18 is one of the five great sermons recorded by Matthew. He deals in this passage with problems affecting the local Christian community. The community has a course of action when dealing with the sinner: First, there is private correction. If this fails, then witnesses are called upon to help make the point. As a last resort, the person is excommunicated. Justice is a communal experience.

We welcome Ezra Lippert to our parishes this weekend. Ezra is a seminarian for the Diocese of Winona-Rochester who was assigned by Bishop Quinn for his Pastoral Year at our parishes for this 2020-2021 school year. Ezra has completed 2 years of theology at Sacred Heart Major Seminary in Detroit.
