just a little reminder as we begin the New Year for our Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist...

- 1) Please remember to stand back when you are at the altar, near the credence tables away from the altar, not in the middle in between the credence table and the altar. When it is time for you to receive, then come forward. The focus should be Father and the Eucharist
- 2) There is to be 6 EM on the altar, one in the middle with the priest (usually the Tabernacle person) 4 for each side, and one for the choir (when Dave K. is there) . The only time this would change is when there is a concelebrating priest or a deacon, at that point, it was decided that the Tabernacle person would stay back.
- 3) Please pay attention as to how many EM's are on the altar and if there is not enough please come up to help and serve. Many of the same people are going up each week and that is not fair.

We all know that things come up and sometimes you may not make Mass but please find a replacement if possible, don't assume someone will take your place. If you need a phone list, let me know

The schedule for each week is now printed in the bulletin so you will be able to see if someone is missing.

- 4) If you are a minister to the home bound when you are discharged by the priest or deacon you are to leave the church immediately with the Eucharist and go directly to the homes or Nursing facilities. You are not permitted to stop anywhere or do anything while you have the Eucharist with you.
