Parishes using OCP music do not need a license to use their music for online streaming at this time, but must list the music used on their website for proper acknowledgement.
- Ecatholic: There is a lot of music you need a license for if you are using in a live stream Mass. Here's a good resource that explains more:

- If you want to use music, the best bet is using anything in the Liturgy of the Hours, since almost all of that is too old to have a copyright attached. Also, anything Gregorian should be safe (just double check). The next option is for the parish to pay for a license through "One License"
