

# Fourth Grade Catechesis Objectives

*Upon completion, youth will be able to:*

1. Explain what is Original Sin. (CCC#386-420)
2. Describe how to rebuild their relationship with God when they have failed to live by God's laws. (CCC# 774-776, 1088, 876, 1551, 2420)
3. Recite the Ten Commandments and explain how to live them in a life-giving way. (CCC# 700, 2050-2075)
4. Name and explain the Precepts of the Church. (CCC# 2041-2043)
5. Discuss practical ways to live the Beatitudes and virtues, making the connection that moral and holy actions are characteristic of being Disciples of Christ. (CCC# 1716-1724)
6. Explain the significance of the Annunciation and Mary's obedience of faith. (CCC# 963, 485, 491-492, 509, 723, 966, 2678, 2708)
7. Participate in various forms of devotion and prayer (spontaneous prayer, blessings, adoration, prayer services, litanies, Stations of the Cross, novenas, chaplets, petitions, intercession, thanksgiving, praise).
