

Kindergarten Catechesis Objectives

Upon completion, youth will be able to reiterate that:

1. God created everyone and each person has dignity. (CCC 27-31, 355-356, 704)
2. God gives us many people to love and He shows His love for us through the love of our parents, friends, priests, brothers, and sisters. (CCC# 2222-2223, 2226)
3. Mary is the mother of God and our mother too. We call Jesus, Mary, and Joseph the Holy Family.
4. The bible is a special book that tells us about God and His love for us. (CCC# 104)
5. We communicate with God through prayer. Prayer is raising our hearts and minds to God by talking and listening to him. We should pray to God every day.
6. Baptism is the sacrament that takes away original sin and makes us members of God's family (the Church).
7. The Mass is a sacred meal that Jesus celebrates with His family. During Mass, Jesus is with us in a special way.
8. God has given us the ability to make choices. We should show our love for God by choosing to follow the commandments He gave us.
9. Students should participate in various forms of devotion and prayer (spontaneous prayer, blessings, adoration, prayer services, litanies, Stations of the Cross, novenas, chaplets, petitions, intercession, thanksgiving, praise). *This objective should be reinforced many times throughout the year.*
