Archdiocesan Policy on Sponsors states:

One sponsor, male or female, is sufficient, but there may be two, one of each sex. They must be at least 16 years of age, be Catholic, confirmed, and have received the Eucharist and live a life of faith which befits the role to be undertaken (Code of Canon Law, §873, §874). They may not be under a canonical penalty nor may they be either the father or mother of the person to be baptized.

A Catholic may not be a sponsor at a non-Catholic baptism. Proxies are no longer used for baptism. If a sponsor cannot be present, someone may stand in for them, but the "proxies" names are not recorded in the official parish records.

The 'life of faith' should include full active and conscious participation in the regular worship of the church, reception of the Eucharist, and celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. If married, a sponsor's marriage should be in harmony with Church laws. Sponsors and godparents should strive to be good examples of our Catholic Christian Faith.
