- I. Opening Prayer
- II. March meeting minutes approved by members present
- III. Pastor's Report
  - a. SPICE is scheduled for Friday, June 4th (virtual event) and is generating a lot of enthusiasm....the Blakeman's and Amy Cannella/Tony Griess are putting forth tremendous effort and have a lot of innovative and exciting ideas
  - b. Father Pietramale will be officially joining Christ the King on July 1st...he will be introduced at all of the masses on July 3-4...details of a welcoming reception will be forthcoming
- IV. Principal's Report
  - a. There are currently 293 students registered for the upcoming school year
  - b. School tours continue to be effective...the new format is working well
  - c. All teacher/staff positions have been filled for the new year
    - i. The new Spanish teacher will be working throughout the summer to build the new Spanish curriculum
    - ii. The new Art teacher has already started to inventory art supplies and set the curriculum for next year
    - iii. The new 5th/6th grade teacher will be working with the existing 5th/6th grade team and setting up summer work dates to prepare for the upcoming year
    - iv. The new Assistant Principal's 17-year teaching background includes Kindergarten, Reading Specialist and Resource Teacher
    - v. Mrs. Stanek is not returning next year...a new Kindergarten teacher has been hired
- V. Old Business
  - a. Mary Carnazzo welcomed the candidates for the four open ESB member positions
  - b. The candidates attending each gave a short introduction about themselves
- VI. New Business
  - a. The Budget and Programs Committee (previous known as the Budget and Curriculum Committee) is planning to meet with the new Spanish teacher in

early summer to hear about the new Spanish curriculum (goals, parameters, development) and provide feedback

- b. A new committee has been formed for Clubs & Activities
  - i. Suggested that we add a club/activities section to the school website
  - ii. Currently developing a list of recommended clubs
  - iii. Considering different payout incentives to encourage teachers to head possible clubs
  - iv. The Marketing Committee, Parent Club, Administration and ESB will work together to form and support clubs going forward
- c. School/Board engagement over the summer and school year
  - i. At May meeting, we will discuss the scheduling of future meetings to align with the times the administration would most need our input on major decisions
  - ii. We will be scheduling a June meeting to discuss items pertinent to the upcoming school year

- a. What is the plan for the Love Ed program going forward? This discussion will be put on the agenda for a future meeting
- b. Mark Dahir gave a brief report about some feedback he had from the Pastoral Council....there seems to be a disconnect between the school and the parish... some suggestions to help with communication between the two entities are:
  - i. Available ESB members to attend the next Pastoral Council meeting on April 27th at 7pm in the Parish Center
  - ii. Add a new section to the ESB meeting agenda, "Pastoral Council Report," where the ESB Pastoral Council Representative (currently Mark Dahir) will give an update on the most recent Council meeting
  - iii. Send information to the Pastoral Council regarding topics the ESB is currently discussing/working on
