A Supporting Catholic is a parishioner registered at St. Rosalie Catholic Church who uses envelopes to contribute at least \$500 per year for one (1) child or \$800 or more for two (2) or more children, or a family who can provide a parish affiliation voucher from a Catholic Church Parish other than St. Rosalie Parish. The deadline to submit a voucher is April 1, 2020 for tuition loans and May 1, 2020 for cash tuition.

A Non-Supporting Catholic is all other families, Catholic and non-Catholic, who are non-parish supporters.

**Payment Options** (Nursery through 7th Grade) — we have two payment options:

- Tuition paid in full by Friday, May 1, 2020
- Bank financed through Gulf Coast Bank & Trust (10-month loan from July 2020 through April 2021. First payment is due on July 1, 2020.)
