The Most Holy Trinity

Sometimes people get a little confused about what the Holy Trinity is. We profess every Sunday: "I believe in One God..." That's incredibly important. There is one divine substance. There are three persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Jesus alludes to this in the Gospel today (John 16:12-15). He speaks of Himself, The Spirit of Truth, and He speaks of His Father. Everything they give, comes from a unity. Jesus ascribes names to each person, also. When we are baptized, we are drawn into the very life of the Holy Trinity. The Holy Trinity is a perfect communion of persons. We are offered Baptism to be brought into this communion – this sharing of life and love. In Baptism, we are also brought into the life of the Church – the Mystical Body of Christ, which is One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic. This is the communion that we share, and the communion we are invited into. Our human nature has been touched by original sin, and therefore we are not perfect, and we are prone to falling into division, even in the Church. History shows us that. But this one-ness, this unity is something we are called to work for and obtain. Let us then rely on the power of the Holy Trinity and pray and work and seek to build bridges and work for unity among ourselves in every way.
