Trinity Sunday

If we stop and really take a look at the world around us and take in the beauty of God's creation and we delve into the physical and biological intricacies that go into every living thing, we begin to see the awesome and powerful mystery of God. Today we celebrate the essential doctrine of our faith, that there are three persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit sharing the same divine nature in one God. We Catholics begin and end every prayer with the Sign of the Cross, "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." We pray the Glory Be at the end of every decade of the Rosary and at the end of the every psalm in the Liturgy of the Hours. And we are baptized "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit," as we have been instructed by Jesus to do. When we enter the Church, we pass the baptismal font and remember our baptisms as we bring our prayers and sacrifices into the Church and we remember our baptisms as we go back out into the world to live in union with the divine life that was shared with us and infused into us. Let us remember our call to live and love as Christ does, not just when we leave the Church, but at every moment of our lives, calling upon the grace that we have been given.

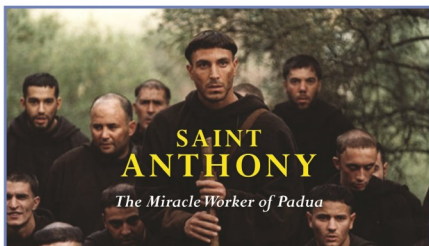
