“No Fear”

A few years ago, it was popular to have a sticker on the back of your truck that said, “No Fear.” People would ride around town showing that off on their rear windshield. This might have been more about doing dangerous or adventurous things than about living with a Christian World view, but this is at the heart of the message of the Gospel today. Jesus says, “Fear no one...” and “do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul.” This is very much what we need to hear in these days of pandemic. The Coronavirus can kill our bodies, but it can't kill our souls. So many other things have this power as well. In Pope Francis' Urbi et Orbi message, to the City of Rome and the world, he reminded us of Jesus' words, “Do not be afraid.” Pope Francis prayed, “You ask us not to be afraid. Yet our faith is weak and we are fearful. But you, Lord, will not leave us at the mercy of the storm. Tell us again: “Do not be afraid” (*Mt 28:5*). And we, together with Peter, “cast all our anxieties onto you, for you care about us” (cf. *1 Pet 5:7*). This is so true, God is a personal God, who cares for us. And we look to Him for salvation. And when we have faith in Him and decide to have a relationship with Him and follow Him as disciples, we should not be afraid.
