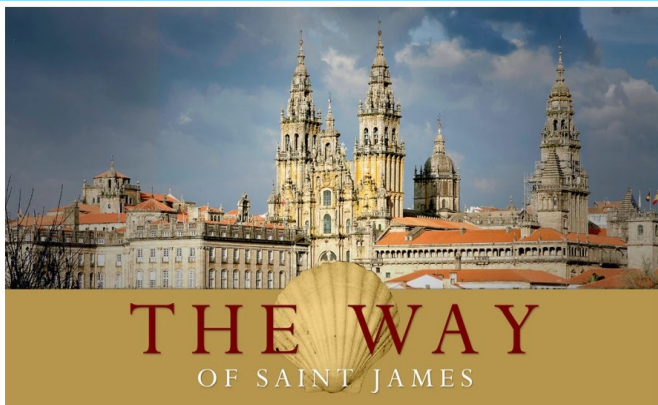
Candidates should have the following:
