Dear CYO Athletic Director,

The Oakland Diocese Catholic Youth Organization (CYO) extends an invitation to you to attend our 32nd annual **CYO ATHLETIC DIRECTORS' SEMINAR!**

The Seminar will be on **Saturday, September 21** at a new location, the Ivaldi Student Center at Moreau Catholic High School, 27170 Mission Blvd., Hayward. Registration will begin at 8:00 a.m. and Mass will begin at 8:30 a.m. Presentations and discussion groups for athletic directors will follow. The day will conclude with lunch at 12:15 p.m. During lunch, there will be an optional session for **New ADs**.

At the Seminar, new and experienced CYO athletic directors will meet to pray, to share ideas and to discuss issues about their ministry in parish and Catholic school CYO programs. The seminar stresses two important areas of concern – the "nuts and bolts" of administering an athletic program and the value of athletics in the development of our young players. The goal of the seminar is to help CYO athletic directors effectively interact with and support their parishes, Catholic schools, coaches, parents and officials in their role of facilitating this important ministry to our young people.

The AD Seminar will begin with a special **Celebration of the Eucharist**, gathering all of us around the Lord's Table to officially begin our seasons. The celebrant will be **Father Mike Nafable**, parochial vicar at St. Patrick Church, Rodeo, former CYO player and an active CYO supporter. All AD's and assistants are invited and encouraged to attend, both Catholics and non-Catholics.

Next, we will have several keynote addresses: Kathleen Radecke, Diocesan Superintendent of Catholic Schools, Rodney Pierre-Antoine, Director of the Lumen Christi Academies, and Jocelyn Pierre-Antione, Assistant School Superintendent. All are dynamic speakers with extensive CYO experience as players, coaches and administrators. They will be presenting on CYO from a variety of perspectives: player, coach and AD. This will be inspirational as we begin our seasons!

Following the keynotes, we will have groups discussions on a variety of topics including recruiting and managing coaches, working with parents, supporting our referees and keeping CYO as a valuable parish ministry, among others.

*Those attending will be certified to coach for the 2019–2020 seasons. (Attending the Seminar will certify ONLY Athletic Directors, Assistants ADs and parish CYO board members.) Attendees will receive a CYO AD Lanyard, AD Certification Card and a copy of the 2019-2020 AD Handbook. There is no charge for registration and lunch.*
