The school is located in the City of Concord, 25 miles east of San Francisco on a 20 acre campus characterized by beauty and openness.

The Bishop John S. Cummins Student Support Coordinator will work as an advocate for current and incoming De La Salle students and their families who have been identified as Bishop John S. Cummins Scholarship scholars. This is a program that seeks to live our Lasallian charism and break the cycle of poverty by attracting and retaining students who are at or below 185% of the Federal poverty line (reduced or free lunch program) and ensure they reach their full potential in school and life.

- Supports the programs that serve students and contributes to their development.

- Coordinate and supervise all Student Support Services offered to 50-70 Bishop John S. Cummins Scholarship Program students.
- Create and implement a system to track the success of Bishop John S. Cummins students (class to class, and in college).
- Conduct in-service trainings and workshops to raise awareness of the issues faced by this diverse population and be a leader in school-wide efforts connected to diversity, equity, and inclusion.
- Connect with best practices and stay up to date on current methodologies and pedagogy for working with diverse populations of young men.
- Has the skills to work with a variety of student needs and the ability to address multiple learning styles.
- Uses school-based technology well, embraces effective practices in curriculum development and assessment of students, and demonstrates strong communication skills, both written and verbal.
