- 2 weeks left of football, then playoffs
- Bylaws are completed, the new SVTM board will take effect in January
  - We need to find 2 representatives to represent St. V on this board

- GCCYS tournament – Angie will pick up trophies Friday
- Bill Franz is looking for date to schedule coaches meeting for basketball
  - Rob suggesting have the Booster meeting on November 5<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 and then the coaches meeting following that.

#### Girls AD – Angie Ford

- 3<sup>rd</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> Grade girls will each have 2 teams for basketball so they will have evaluations – dates/times scheduled – October 17<sup>th</sup>
- No tryouts necessary for any of the other grades for girls
- Coaches are all set for all girls grades
- Money for Pink Out will go to Breast Cancer Research foundation
  - We raised about \$850
- Ordered shirts for the 8<sup>th</sup> grade A team volleyball because they won in their bracket

#### Boys AD – Rob Buehner

- 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade initial evaluations will be on 10/15, there will be a 2<sup>nd</sup> evaluation on 10/22 if needed
- 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> evaluations will be on 10/21
- We don't have an "A" coach for 7<sup>th</sup> grade yet
- 93 boys registered
- 3<sup>rd</sup> grade – 16 players – 2 teams
- 4<sup>th</sup> grade – 12 players – 2 teams
  - They are still trying to recruit a few other kids
  - Angie suggested making sure they try to have one of their practices together
  - Rob said he will explore the GCCYS rules regarding borrowing a player from the other team
- 5<sup>th</sup> grade – 15 boys
- 6<sup>th</sup> grade – 22 boys 1 A team, 2 B teams
- 7<sup>th</sup> grade – 13 boys, we will try to do an A and B team
  - Couldn't find a non-parent A coach, but has a possible parent coach identified
  - Has B team coach identified
- 8<sup>th</sup> grade – 15 boys, A team / B team – both coaches back
- Hoopsters has 36 (Hoopsters starts 10/26)
  - 20 for K/1
  - 16 for 2<sup>nd</sup>

- Team Registrations all have to be submitted by 10/15, slotting meeting is on 10/16
