

Confirmation Dress Code

- Confirmation is a Sacrament that is celebrated with much reverence, joy, and dignity. The attire worn by both the Confirmation Candidate and his/her Sponsor should reflect the same.
- Attire during the Confirmation Mass, for both candidates and sponsors, should be Christmas or Easter best, respecting Christian modesty and Church tradition. Traditionally, this has been as follows:

What should candidates wear for Confirmation?

Women Men Dark or Khaki Colored Dress Dress or Skirt and Blouse Pants (no jeans or cargo pants) Dresses and skirts must be knee length or longer with a modest • Suit or Sport Jacket (optional) neckline; back and shoulders MUST be covered. Dress Shirt and Tie Dress Pants/Blouse Dress Socks and Dress Shoes Dress Shoes (you should be (no gym shoes) able to walk comfortably)

Please be sure your forehead is uncovered (free from hair or hair accessories) for Anointing from the Bishop.
