



# Confirmation Dress Code

- Confirmation is a Sacrament that is celebrated with much reverence, joy, and dignity. The attire worn by both the Confirmation Candidate and his/her Sponsor should reflect the same.
- Attire during the Confirmation Mass, for both candidates and sponsors, should be Christmas or Easter best, respecting Christian modesty and Church tradition. Traditionally, this has been as follows:

## What should candidates wear for Confirmation?

Women	Men
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Dress or Skirt and Blouse</li></ul> <p><i>Dresses and skirts must be knee length or longer with a modest neckline; back and shoulders MUST be covered.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Dress Pants/Blouse</li><li>• Dress Shoes <i>(you should be able to walk comfortably)</i></li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Dark or Khaki Colored Dress Pants <i>(no jeans or cargo pants)</i></li><li>• Suit or Sport Jacket <i>(optional)</i></li><li>• Dress Shirt and Tie</li><li>• Dress Socks and Dress Shoes <i>(no gym shoes)</i></li></ul>

*Please be sure your forehead is uncovered (free from hair or hair accessories) for Anointing from the Bishop.*
