SPIRITUAL POTLUCK – from Sister Libby, O.Carm.

On-going Formation: Separate the community members by assigning different tables than when they first arrived. **Always allow 1.5 hrs.** In your reading at home, underline or highlight what touches your heart and what you don't understand. You are now prepared to do your part in sharing for the on-going formation. To begin with, circle the table 3 times twice so everyone has a chance to put their ingredients into the soup pot for the ingredients to simmer. **No talking, just putting into the soup pot.** The last time is when you pull out the ingredients and savor the taste of the gumbo by having a free-flowing discussion.

1. Putting the ingredients into the pot: **Circle the table 3 times letting each person have their turn in what spoke to them, what they didn't understand, etc.** Again, example: Page 15, 2nd paragraph, 3rd sentence. Read it out loud. The rest of the group puts a mark beside your offering. Go on to the next person at the table. **No discussion.**

2. Simmering the ingredients: Now circle the table 3 times once again and let each person pull out what was mentioned in Step 1 and **how it relates to the Lay Carmelite life, what is the challenge, where is the inspiration.** Go on to the next person at the table. **No discussion yet.**

3. Savoring the ingredients: **Now is the time for discussion. It should be free-flowing.**
