



ST. ELIZABETH SCHOOL EXTENDED CARE PROGRAM

For the convenience of our working parents, St. Elizabeth School offers an Extended School Program that operates on the ground floor of St. Elizabeth School. School staff and professional caregivers work daily with the students. The Before Care Program begins at 7:00 a.m. during most school days and the After Care Program begins during afternoon dismissal and runs until 6:00 p.m. on regular school days and until 4:30 p.m. on scheduled early dismissals.



Our morning care staff provides a welcoming, calm space for students to acclimate to the school day. Parents are asked to accompany their children into the APR, by way of the gym entrance, and officially sign their child into the program. Students are welcome to play with games, read books, color, study, or simply relax before the 8:00am bell.

Our afternoon care staff appreciates each student's need to wind down from the rigors of the school day. Upon arrival, students will have time and opportunity to play outdoors on our athletic field, weather permitting, or indoors in our gymnasium, eat a snack, and enjoy socializing with peers. Students work in small groups during homework/reading time with individual staff members. On Fridays or prior to holidays, students often enjoy watching G-rated videos or have time for general play rather than homework.



The Extended School Program is designed to provide a safe, nurturing environment that embodies the teachings of Christ and St. Elizabeth School. Safety and security of the participating students is the pre-eminent goal of the program. We are happy to work with the parents and students. A non-refundable deposit of \$50.00 is required for students to be registered. The 2019-2020 cost for one child is \$17.00 a day (4-5 days/week) or \$19.00 a day (2-3 days/week) for afternoon care and \$6.50 a day for morning care. Rates are subject to change.
