



## SUMMER CHOICE BOARD

Reading	Math	Sci/Social Studies	Writing	Religion
Flashlight Sight Words: Spread the cards out face up on a table, or tape onto walls, doors, or ceiling. Call out a word and have your child shine the flashlight on the word. Do this with 5-10 words at a time.	Practice writing numbers. You can use chalk, water and paint brushes in the driveway, or paper and pencils.	Practice your phone number. Practice your address. Try writing them.	Practice writing your first and last name. Use capitals for first letters and lowercase for the rest.	Practice praying the Hail Mary prayer.
Walking Sight words: Lay the words in a line on the floor and have your child walk the line as they read each word. Do this with 5-10 words at a time.	Use items from home to count and add groups. Ex: cereal-count out 10 pieces. Then add one more. Now how many do you have? Now take 2 away how many now? You can do this with food, toys, stuffed animals, etc. and with different amounts.	Build with legos, blocks, things around the house. Tell about what you built. How could someone use it? What is it for? Make changes to make your project better.	Use play dough, or markers, crayons, paint to practice writing letters. Say the sounds of letters as you practice.	Tell God thank you for something special that happened today.
Read together, listen to stories online VOOKS is a great site to listen to stories.	Practice counting by 5s, and 10s. You can do this outloud or practice writing the numbers.	Enjoy nature. Draw pictures of animals, insects, and plants you see.	Keep a summer journal. Write and draw pictures.	Lead the family prayer before a meal.
