This can be done by going to www.egiveusa.com/login/ and selecting the "New e-Give Login" on the left, or going to the parish website and selecting "Support Us" under the "Home" tab and selecting "Click Here to Sign Up for e-Give.". Once you have put in your username, click on the "forgot password" link to receive a temporary password in order to access the system. Once you have used your temporary password, you will be prompted to create a new password of your own. *If you run into any difficulty, please contact e-Give directly at 866-303-6623 or support@egive-usa.com, as these are their instructions.* New users should have no issues, and should just follow the prompts to create an account. But please note that, although the system will allow it, you cannot make your donations using a credit card.
