He was inspired to do this because of the courage of a young Chinese girl who, after the Communist take-over, secretly entered a Catholic church where 30 hosts had been thrown on the floor. Each day she crawled into the church and picked up a host with her tongue. On the last day, as she was leaving, a guard saw her and killed her. Bishop Sheen was very moved by her courage. **Every Wednesday from 9:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.** the Blessed Sacrament is on the altar at St. Catherine Church. You are invited to take some time for peace and quiet, to find strength to face daily challenges, and to thank the Lord for his many blessings and constant love.

WANTED: NEW SAFE ENVIRONMENT COORDINATOR

After years of faithful service, our current Safe Environment Coordinator, Lynn Fitzpatrick, has decided to let someone else have the opportunity to serve our parish. Duties for this volunteer position include: keep track of all adults working with children (this includes volunteer coaches, CCD teachers, and Scout leaders (both Boy and Cub), verify that they are compliant with Church requirements, including looking at database from church and State criminal and sex offender registry. Must maintain records of all non- and compliant active people, and meet annually with diocesan officials to go over the book. Coordinator must also maintain a "Saving God's Children" certificate. Training will be available from the diocese, and the candidate must undergo a background check. Anyone interested is asked to call the rectory at 622-4966.
