THANK YOU TO PICNIC ORGANIZERS

THANK YOU FROM OUR PLACE

The majority of the 75 clients currently in our program are low income, so getting a package of diapers, wipes, an outfit and other necessities when they attend their bi-monthly education appointments is a real blessing to them. This year 21 churches and 99 individuals were offered the opportunity to donate. The collection totaled 20 boxes and 12 packages of diapers; 6 packages of wipes; 31 beautiful hand crochet or knit afghans, quilts and receiving blankets; 16 handmade sweaters and sets including hats and booties; 107 crocheted hats; a crocheted doll and 2 teddy bears and 9 burp cloths. In addition to these items, we received generous checks from the Daughters of Isabella, the Women of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of America and one individual. Absolutely fantastic!

THE RESURRECTION OF THE SON OF GOD

How do we know that Jesus was actually raised from the dead in bodily form? This course with Prof. N.T. Wright, *The Resurrection of the Son of God*, examines the extraordinary claim that Jesus of Nazareth was raised from the dead in a bodily fashion to appear in person to people after his cruel death, crucifixion, and entombment. This journey will look at the ancient world's understanding of the afterlife from Jewish and Greek perspectives along with the implications of their understandings as it relates to the early Christian claim of the bodily resurrection of Jesus. New Testament documents will then be examined for broader understanding of resurrection generally as well as for specific information as it relates to the claim that Jesus was raised from the dead in bodily form. This course will meet for eight sessions, beginning Tuesday, **June 18** at 7 p.m. in the parish hall.

IGNATIAN EIGHT WEEK RETREAT IN EVERYDAY LIFE

This retreat mirrors the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola, but in an abbreviated format. Retreatants go about their everyday life, but commit to pray each day, following a guided structure of readings and reflections. We will gather weekly for these eight weeks to share the fruit of each one's prayer. Thursdays 7:00-8:30 p.m. ending **July 11**.
